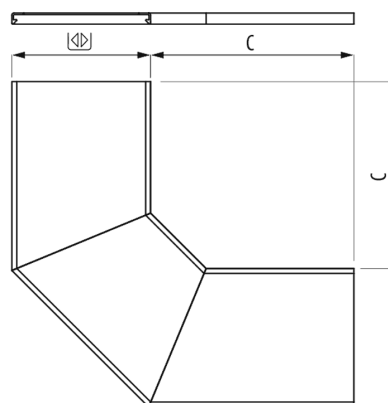
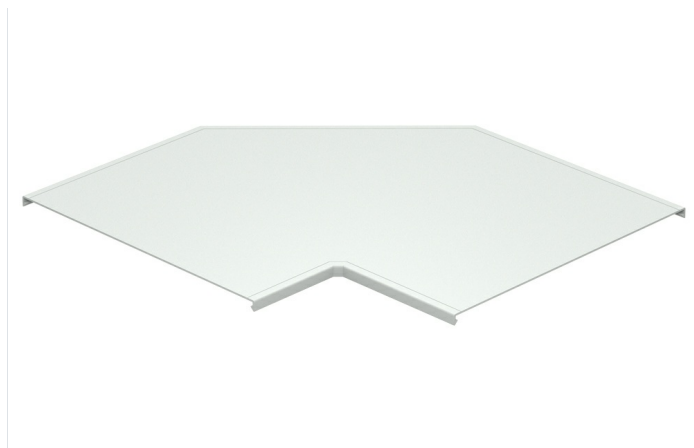


Metatray 90° bend cover (Ref: 82003738)
